

Information for Riding Group Leaders:

(Riding Groups require Executive Committee approval.)

TRA Riding Groups are designed to allow small groups to participate fully in TRA activities. A Riding Group can be started with as little as 2 or more registered TRA members participating. Riding Groups are approved by the Executive Committee of the TRA and are listed on the website along with the Group Leader's name and contact number. A group leader is the only required position. If the group grows in numbers and participation over time, they can apply to become a full chapter.

The Riding Group Leader should:

- Plan group TRA rides as occasion permits.
- If possible, plan temple visits.
- Encourage all participants to become members of the TRA by registering annually and contributing the current annual membership dues.
- Be familiar with the TRA website, templeriders.org, and know how to download the Membership application for prospective members.
- Maintain Church standards on all TRA activities – be good representatives of the Church and the TRA.
- Be familiar with the TRA Bylaws and policy statements and encourage group participants to follow these guidelines.

- Questions should be directed to your State Director, Regional Director or the General Director. However, Executive Committee Members will be happy to answer your questions if called upon.
