

Riding Group Leader Guidelines
Amended and Updated August 2022

(Riding groups leaders require executive committee approval.)

First, thank you! Your willingness to lead a TRA riding group and help our association grow is greatly appreciated by the TRA Executive Committee. Riding groups are designed to allow small groups to participate fully in TRA activities. A group can be started with as little as 2 or more registered TRA members, other than a spouse, participating. They are approved by the executive committee and are listed on the website along with the group leader's name and contact information. A group leader is the only required position. If the group grows in numbers and participation over time, they can apply to become a full chapter.

The Riding Group Leader should strive to:

Plan group TRA rides as occasion permits.

If possible, plan temple visits.

Encourage all participants to become members of the TRA by registering on www.templeriders.com and contributing the current annual membership dues.

Be familiar with the TRA website, www.templeriders.com.

Be familiar with the TRA bylaws and policies and encourage group participants to follow these guidelines.

Welcome those who can support TRA bylaws and observe standards of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints for the duration of any ride or activity in which they are a participant.
